In parallel to diploma and thesis he worked as a tutor and supervisor in the Organic Lab for advanced students.

Starting in 1991, he focused on environmental chemistry and ecotoxicology as employee and worked for the BUA Working Group (Advisory Committee on Existing Chemicals – the committee was financed by Industry (VCI) and German government). Within BUA, main topic of his work was the evaluation of the hazard potential of substances in the field of environmental fate and ecotoxicology. The BUA chemical safety reports (BUA-Reports) were developed and published in cooperation with industry and national and international authorities and institutions (UBA, BfR, BAuA, US EPA, OECD).

The BUA project ceased after 25 years with the implementation of REACH in 2007.

Within CFCS-Consult GmbH, which he founded together with Dr. Barbara Lohmann in 2007, he is senior expert for environmental chemistry, fate and ecotoxicology. Concerning regulatory affairs, Felix has senior experience with Regulation (EC) no. 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), Regulation (EC) no. 1272/2008 on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures (CLP), the Dangerous Substances Directive 67/548 / EEC, the Dangerous Preparations Directive 1999/45 / EC, and the Regulation on Biocidal Products (BPD Regulation (EU) No. 528 / 2012) and gained expert knowledge in special provisions of chemical law in Japan, China and Australia / New Zealand.
